Covid 19: Since Monday 6th of September the capacity for Church attendance has been increased to 50%. To accommodate 50% attendance, we have opened up all seats in the Church. We ask people to observe social distancing as far as possible and to respect other people's space and to use the full area of the Church. We ask people to continue to wear face masks and to sanitise your hands on entrance and exit from the Church. Communion will be distributed from the front of the Church, as before covid. Please come forward in an orderly fashion beginning from the front seats. A priest or minister will come to the back of the Church for those who cannot come forward and communion will be distributed in the gallery for those seated in the gallery. Please continue to receive communion in the hand at this time. We thank the stewards and those sanitising the church. If you would like to help in stewarding or sanitising please let us know. We thank you for your cooperation.
